#### **Pavilion Rentals**

Pavilion #2 - located near park entrance.
Has electric, can hold 75 people, barbeque grill, and horseshoes are available.

\*\*Refunds are given to cancellations that are made at least 30 days prior to the event.

Rental of pavilion is from 10 a.m. - 9 p.m. Contact Chemung County Buildings & Grounds at 607-737-2843 for reservations. Reservations can be accepted the first business day in January for the upcoming season. Reservations are accepted by telephone only on the first two (2) business days in January after which you may call or come into the office to reserve. Payment is expected within 10 business days of making your reservation. A reservation made less than 10 days from reservation date must be followed by payment on or before the next business day. If you are planning to have a caterer/alcohol or inflatables at our rental facilities you must have prior authorization through the Chemung County Attorney. In order to receive authorization you must provide us with a Comprehensive General Liability policy of no less than \$1,000,000 of coverage per person/occurrence and aggregate naming the County of Chemung as an "Additional Insured". This policy must also include Host Liquor Liability Coverage if you are planning to have alcohol. This policy must be submitted to the Chemung County Buildings and Grounds Department not less than 30 days prior to your event.

#### **Swimming Information**

- Swimming is permitted in designated areas only and only when lifeguards are on duty.
   \*Swimming is open the third Saturday in June through Labor Day 12 - 6 p.m. weather permitting.
- Floatation devices are not allowed. NO EXCEPTIONS
- Children less than 16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Children under the age of 10 must have an adult in the water with them at all times.
- No prolonged breath holding or breath holding games.
- Water Safety in the event of thunder or lightning the waterfront will be closed. It will remain closed until 30 minutes from the last thunder or lightning observation. There are no refunds due to weather.
- Every effort is made to provide safe swimming opportunities by testing the water and by keeping the swimming area staffed with lifeguards. Please be aware that if the safety of our swimmers is compromised, due to lack of lifeguard coverage or water quality issues, swimming will be prohibited and therefore cannot be a guaranteed activity. We apologize for this inconvenience as it may occur with little or no advance notice.

**Control Booth** - open 10 a.m.-5 p.m. and **Snack Bar -** open 12-6 p.m. weekends only during Memorial Day Weekend - 3rd Saturday in June after which the Control Booth and the Snack Bar will be open daily through Labor Day Weekend.

Park Station has 40 large, wooded campsites some of which are located on a 100 acre lake. Each campsite provides electric (30 amp), a picnic table, and a fire ring. Also available in the Park are flush toilets, hot/cold showers, a laundry facility, vending machines, dumping station, water taps, garbage receptacles, playgrounds, and a camp store.

- **Registration** you must register with the Campground Office upon arrival. Please notify the Campground Office if you leave your site for more than 24 hours.
- Minimum Age you must be 18 years of age or older to rent a site. This responsible person must remain on the site for the entire term of occupancy.
- Check In Time as early as 2:00 p.m.
- Check Out Time as late as 12:30 p.m.
- **Quiet Hours** 11:00 p.m. 7:00 a.m. All loud noises, both human and equipment will cease during quiet hours.
- Water prior to memorial day and after the last weekend in September there is no guarantee that water will be available in the campground or at the dump station.

- **Campsites** must be kept clean at all times. Any / all debris is to be removed by the campers (ex. lawn chairs, carpet, containers, etc.)
- **Grey Water** is to be dumped at the dump station ONLY.
- **Smoking** permitted at your campsite and at designated smoking area near the entrance of the park.
- Alcohol permitted in the campground ONLY unless a permit has been issued.
- Visitors must pay the daily entrance fee and may be required to park their vehicle in the parking lot outside of the campground. Visitors must vacate the campground by 10:00 p.m.
- **Occupancy-**limited to 6 (six) persons or one family group (mother, father and minor children and one (1) single relative)
- Equipment permitted you may have one camper (up to 35 feet) and one tent per site OR two tents per site
- Fires allowed only in fire rings. Firewood may be purchased in the Campground Office. If bringing your own firewood please refer to our "Don't Move Firewood!" literature.
- Trash place all trash in trash can provided
- Trenching prohibited
  - Portable Potties prohibited
- **Laundry** please do not hang your laundry on a clothesline to dry. Swim suits and camping gear are acceptable.
- Vehicles 2 per site after 10:00 p.m. Please keep your vehicles on the gravel provided.
- Playground is closed at dusk.
- All children 17 and under must be at their campsite between 11pm-7am.



- **Consideration of Others** Please note that we reserve the right to evict, without refund, anyone violating these rules, destroying property, creating a disturbance, or engaging in behavior not suitable in a family campground.
- Please do not walk across other occupied sites. Remember that an occupied site is another camper's home.
- No refunds for early departure, no-shows, late arrivals, inclement weather, personal reasons, etc.
- Pets dogs, cats and other domesticated pets are only permitted in the campgrounds at Park Station controlled at all times by a leash not more than eight (8) feet long.
  - \*You must clean up after your pet. Owners are responsible for leaving the site in a clean and sanitary condition.
  - \*Proof of a current rabies inoculation is required for dogs.
  - \*No animals may be left unattended in the Park. \*If your pet is outside, you must be outside
  - with your pet. \*Pets must not disturb or pose a danger to
  - other guests.
  - \*Pets are not allowed in any buildings or on any beaches.
  - \*Owners may be asked to remove their animal if the animal is causing a disturbance or being a nuisance to Park patrons or Park personnel.

\*\*\*Campers must leave your site clean and free of debris and garbage. All garbage should be put in the dumpster. It should look as it did when you arrived.

There will be a \$25.00 fee charged if a site needs to be cleaned after you leave. If there are damages (including destruction of trees) the fee may be significantly more. Future camping is on hold until fees are paid. Reservations can be made up to 9 months prior to your stay and must be paid in full at the time of booking. Minimum stay for weekends is 2 nights and minimum stay for holidays is 3 nights.

#### Site or Date Changes:

A \$3.50 reservation change fee will be charged to make a change to any reservation.

#### Cancellations:

Cancelling 0-6 days prior to arrival, you will receive a 50% refund (excluding the non-refundable Reservation fee of \$3.50).

Cancelling 7 or more days prior to arrival you will receive a refund (excluding the non-refundable Reservation fee \$3.50). You will be charged a Cancellation Fee of \$3.50.
